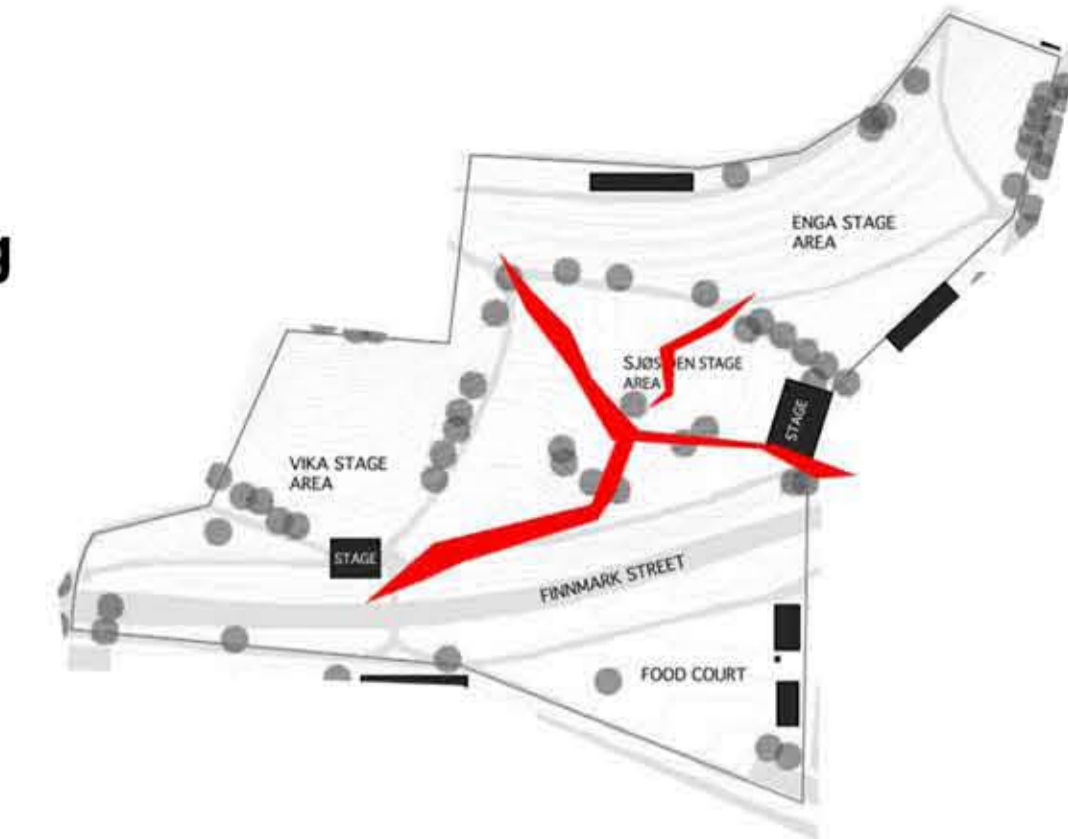
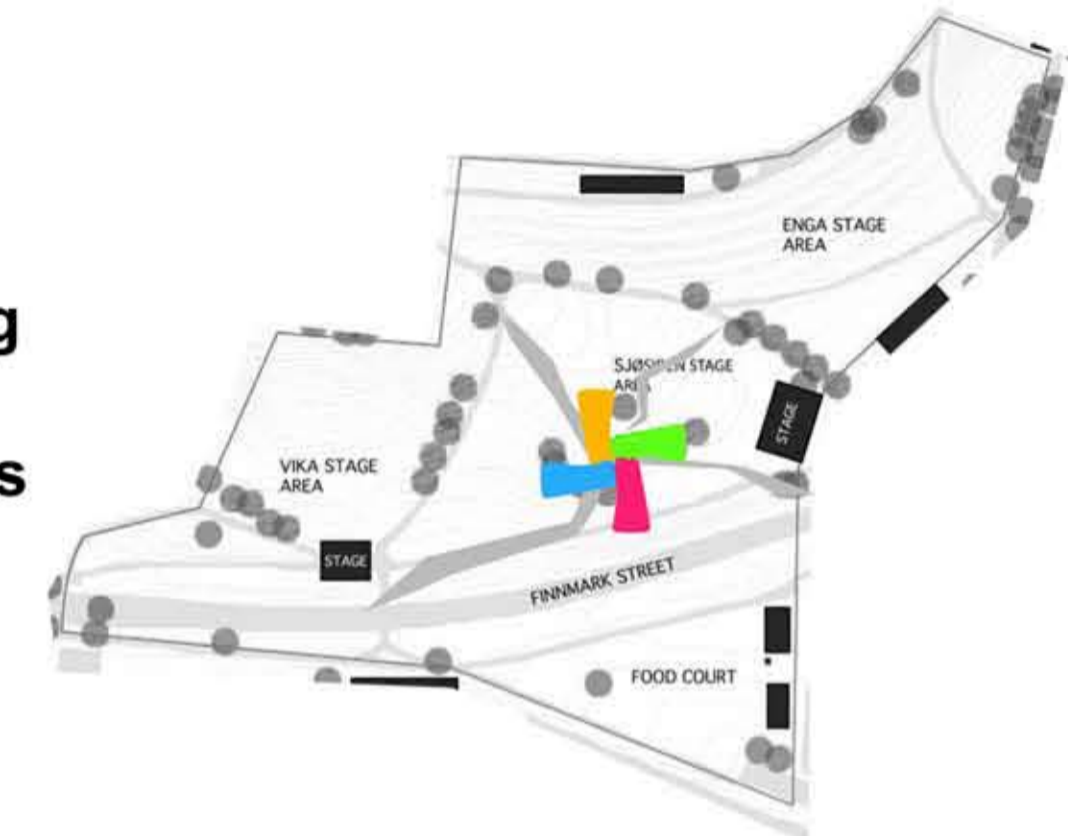




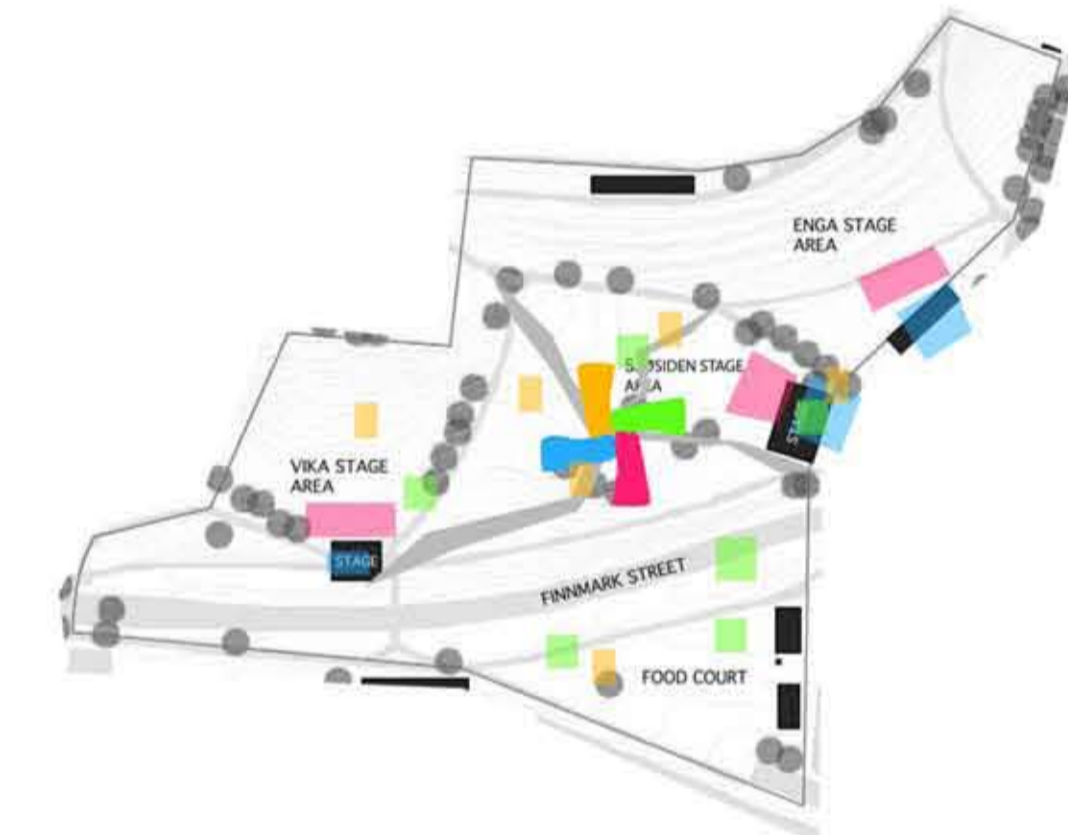
Movement- Connecting the paths to a central intersection

The Pavilion is made up of four colours which resemble a function and activity helping the festival in a manner which can transform the energy and use it in a more productive manner.
