'HOUSE WITHOUT FUNCTION'

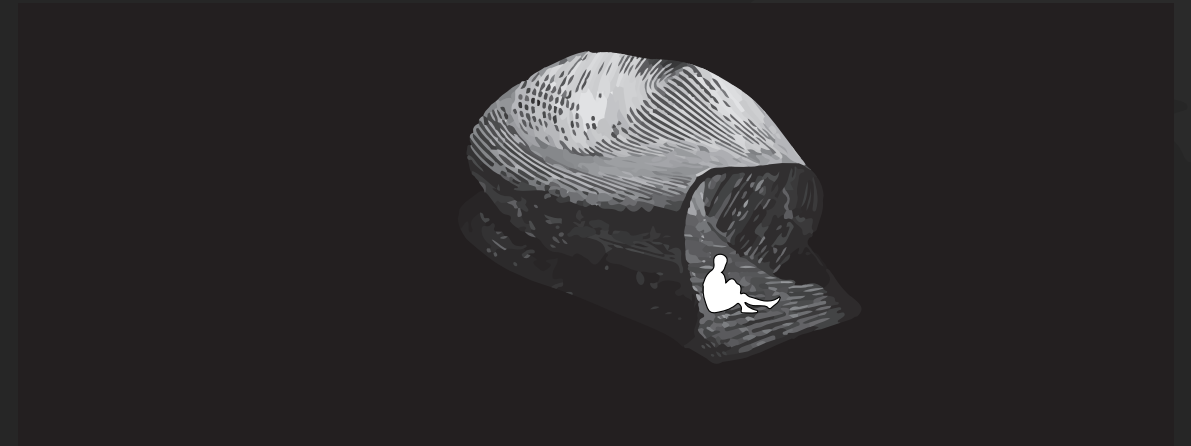
Very first space in which human is contained/carried is mother's womb. The fact that the user is unaware, womb still has a physical context and purpose.

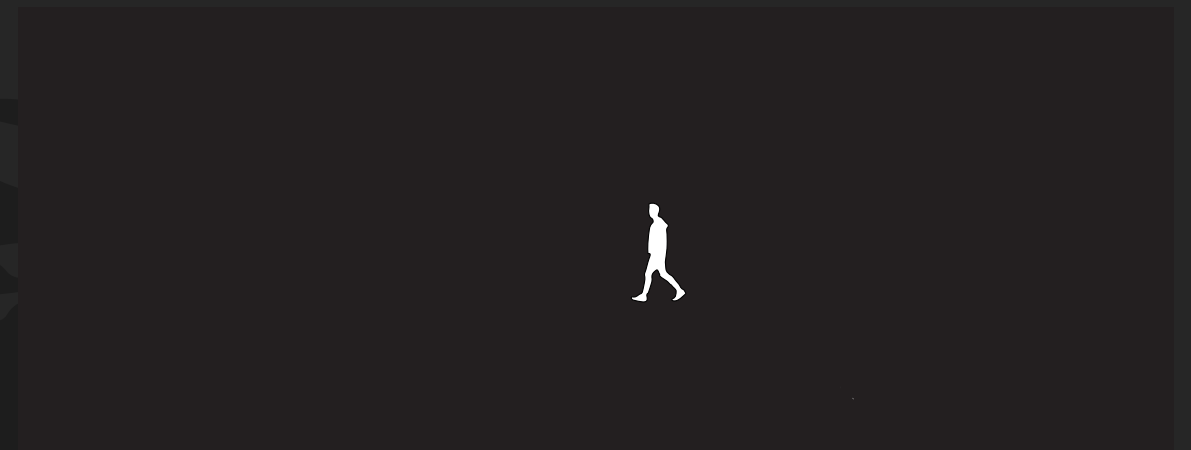
OR
