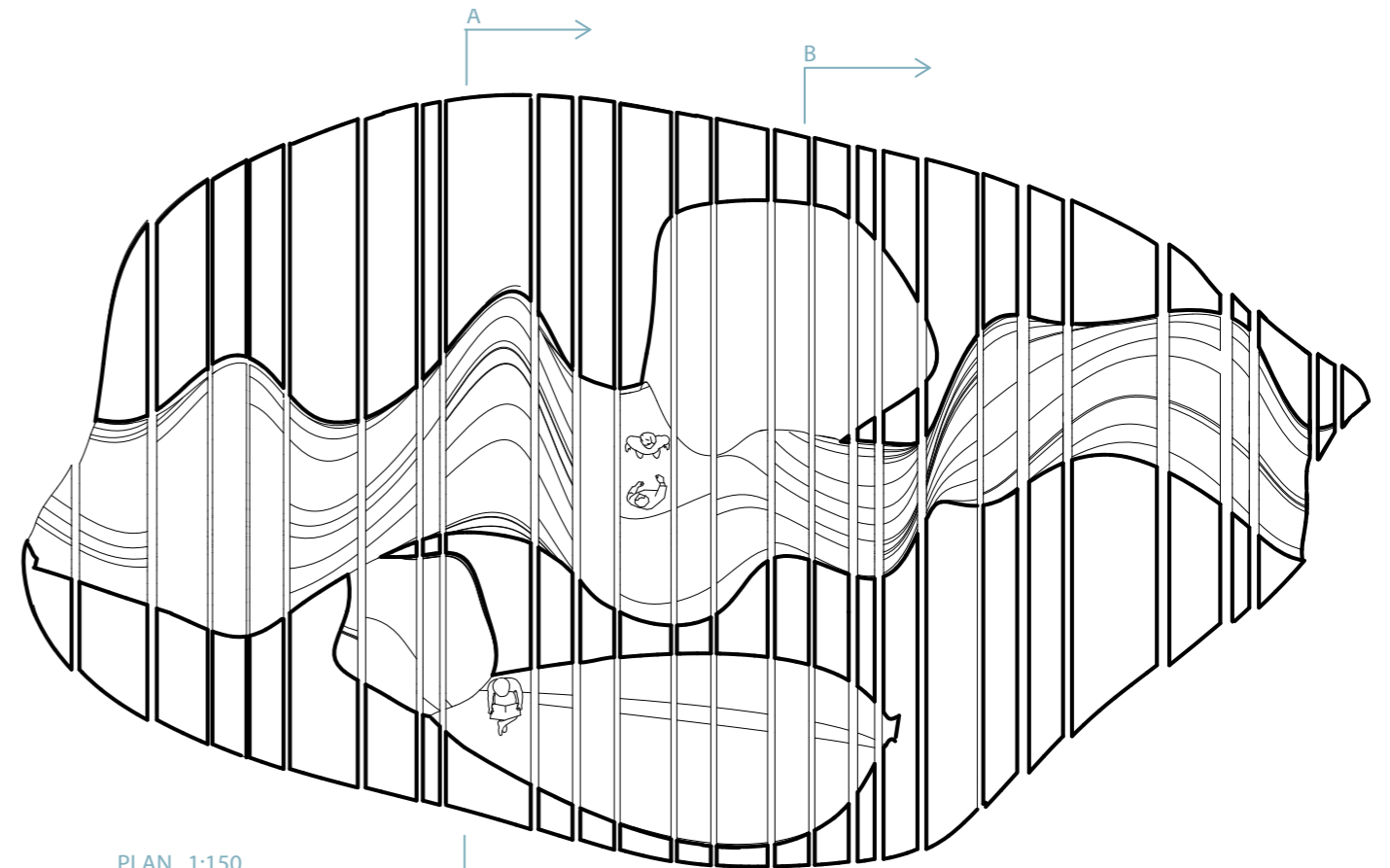


# SYMBIOSIS

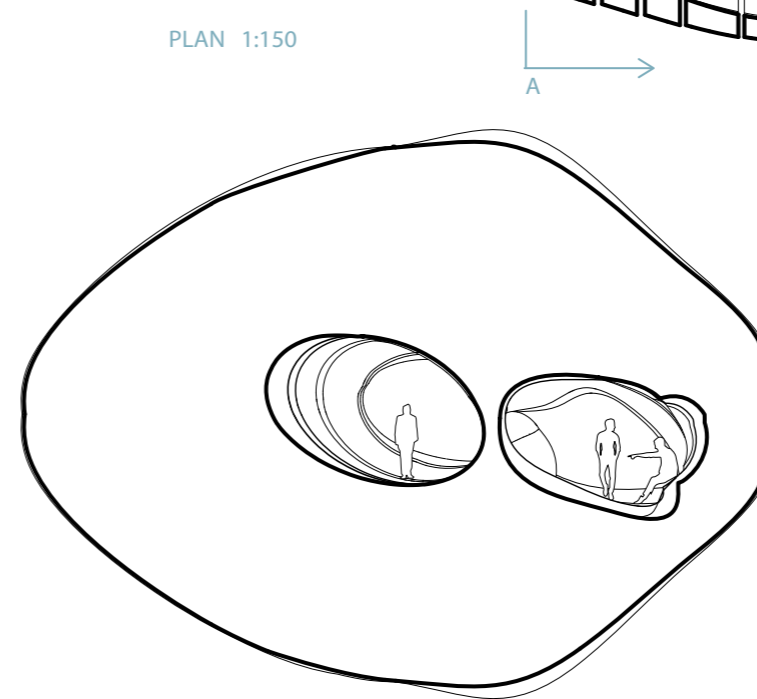

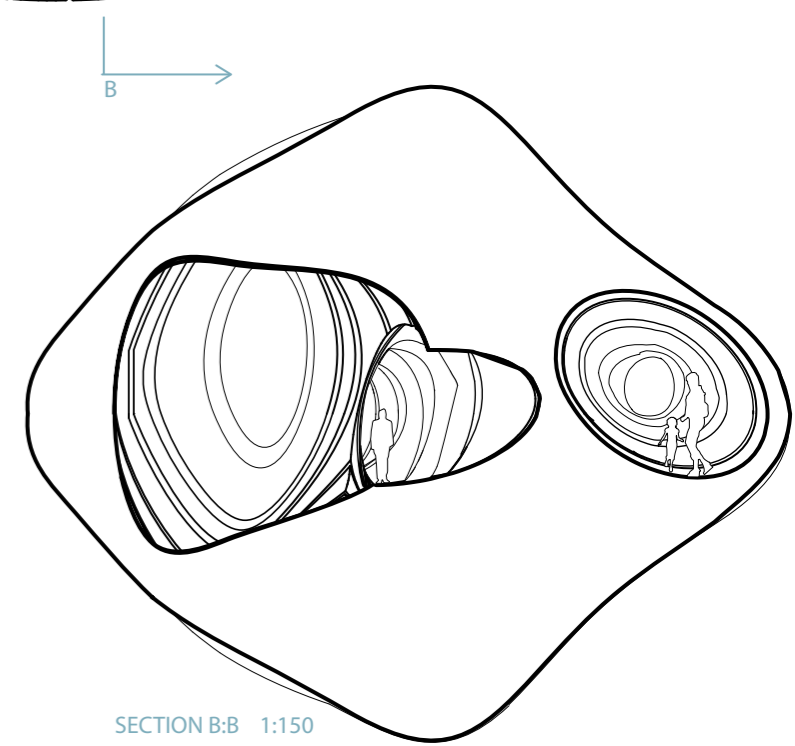
