



HOUSE FOR EVERYONE AND NO ONE

A house is a space that exists to satisfy the basic needs of its temporary users, until someone turns it into a permanent residence, a home.

A house, with no intension to turn into a home, is a building with temporary occupants, and thus has no function at all. Can we imagine this place creating simultaneously different living conditions and various spatial qualities, satisfying human diversity? "Our" house is a proposal for a new social interaction between humans and built world. One can enter this built space and stay for a short period of time.

The basic structure follows a post and beam solution with roof on steel columns, to establish personal spaces. A secondary grid, outlined by wooden beams, creates a zone of human interaction, which changes identity depending on the occupants' will and on alternations of light and shadow, creating new spatial experiences every time.
