Asking ourselves that questions, we've created the system of a minimal human-scale tubes, located everywhere in the world, looking just the same.

The tiny one-night shelters can ensure every nomad that, no matter where he is, he will always find a safe place where "feels like at home". In every corner there would be a recognisable form, giving him the courage to travel and arousing the feeling that the whole world is the home, because everywhere there are the spaces he identify with.

Sleeping tubes are made of two layers of extensible material and the oxygen between them. The mattress pump up while pulling the construction out of the wall and pump out pushing it back. During the day the houses are hidden and only change the landscape after nightfall.
