A space inspired by the ideals of Buyi architecture, blending elements branching from the Chinese craft with function.

Creating a building which, despite being structured and organised, creates a sense of openness which compliments the wonder and exploration of children, by blurring the lines between the canteen and the library.

A structure that serves as a "playground" through it's layered levels, which makes for a seamless flow of movement between floors.
