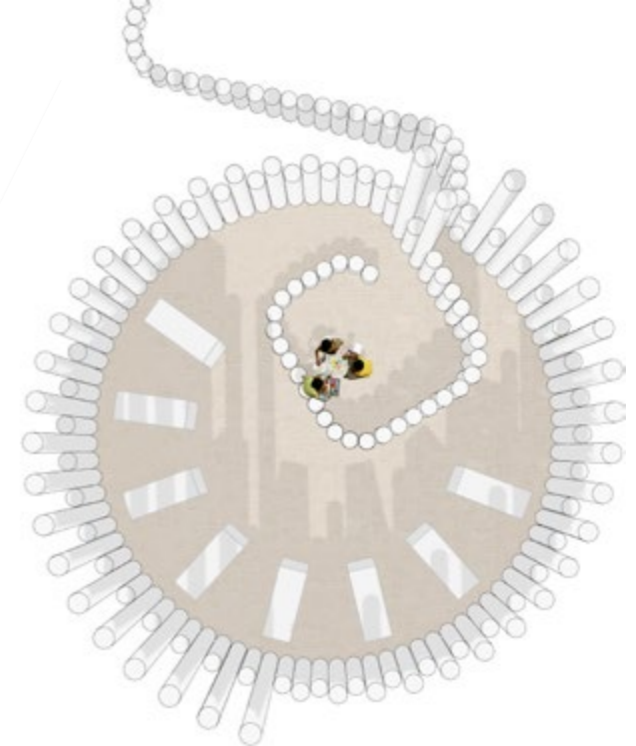
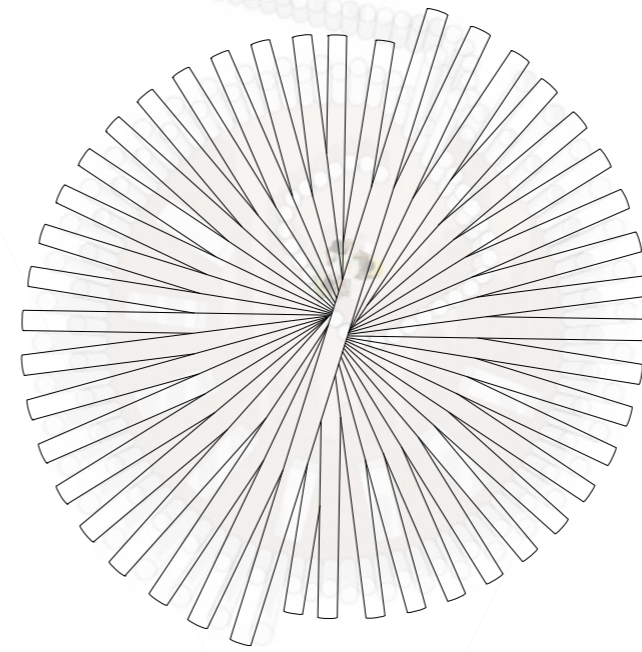

THE CANTINE IS SHELTERED BY A ROOF. THE OPEN SPACE ALLOWS THE CHILDRENS GAZE TO VISIT THE RICE FARMERS WHILE THEY EAT THEIR LUNCH.

THE STAGE CONSIST ONLY OF A BENCH, THE MOUNTAINOUS BACKDROP AND A PROMISE OF UNTOLD STORIES.

THE LIBRARY IS A CLOSED SPACE WITH NO DISTRACTIONS BUT THE RHYTHM OF THE SHADOWS.



THE ROOF STRUCTURE OF THE LIBRARY IS MOUNTED BETWEEN THE INTERVALING POSTS. THEY SPAN 7.5M ACROSS THE SPACE. THEY ARE STACKED ON TOP OF EACH OTHER AND ROTATED - MAKING A ROOF THAT STARTS AT 6M AND DESCENDS TO 2.5M

WOODEN POSTS ARE THE ONLY STRUCTURAL ELEMENT.
A CLOTH / SAIL IS TIED TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND PROTECTS AGAINST WIND AND RAIN.
