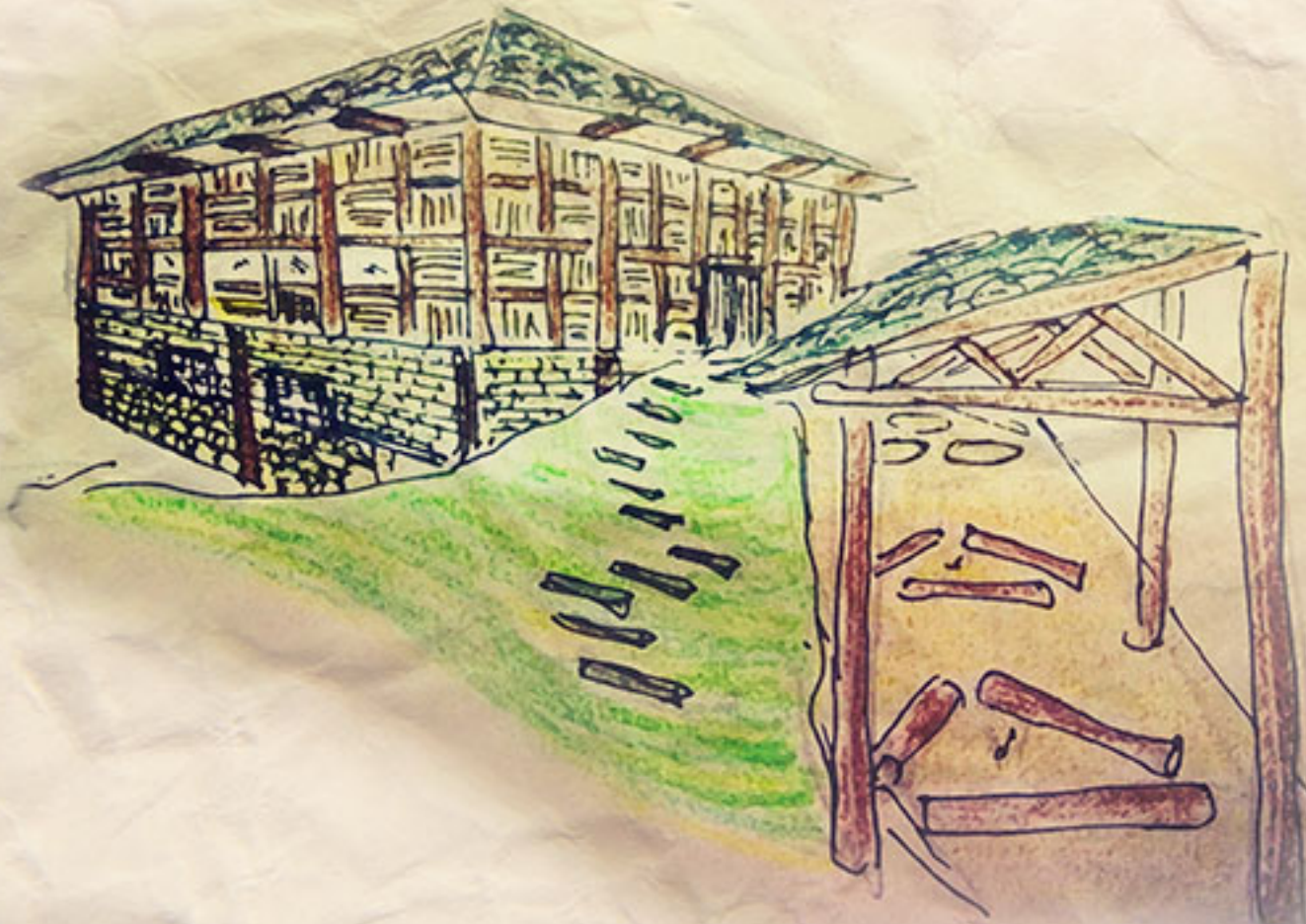


The main idea behind our design is that we wanted to create an interesting space **deviating away a little from the formal library systems.**

As we think of libraries ,usually a default image strikes us that will have a formal sitting space and shelves stacked with books all around .
looking at age group of the users we are designing for (between 6 to 12),
what if we could just totally intermix this setup and **create a lively, colourful and a playful environment for the students to learn in a disciplined way.**

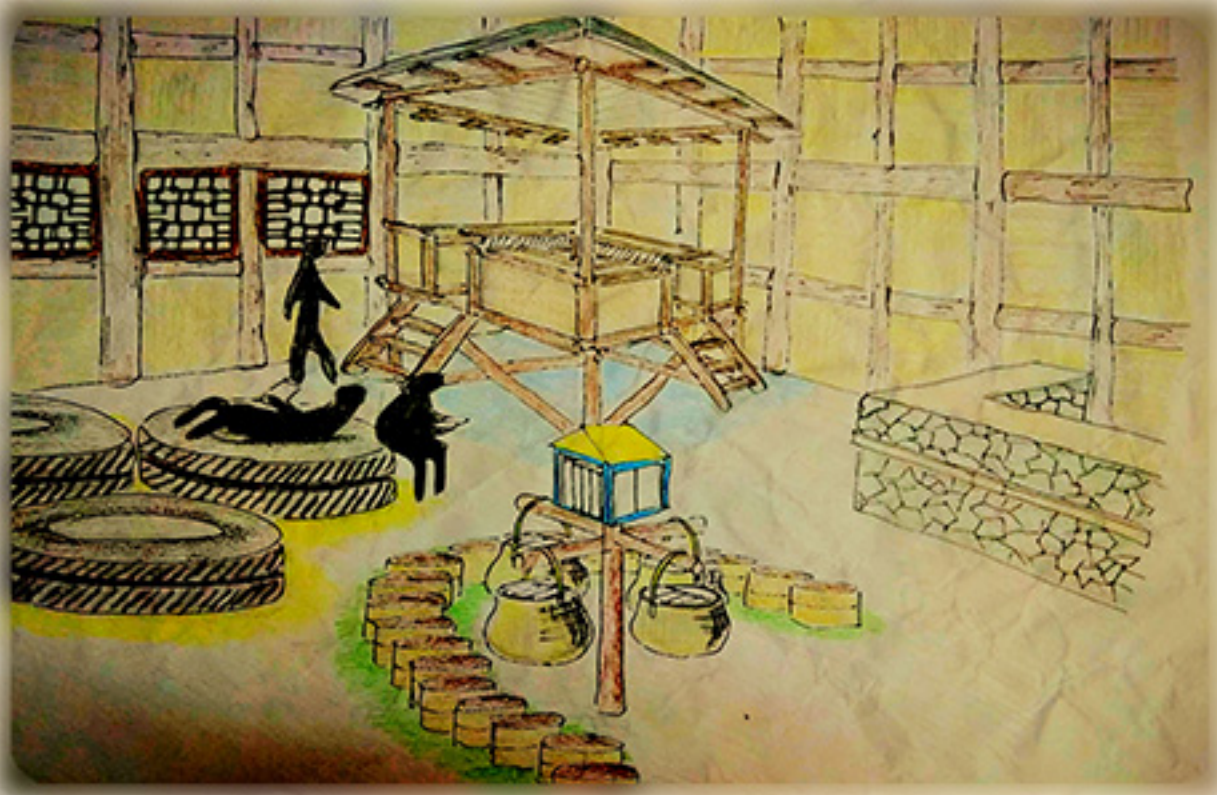
The material used are entirely local ,hence can be available at a very low cost.
The entire library is made of timber members and roof is made of stone tiles.



The lower section holding kitchen and canteen counter is made of stone.
An **open seating space** is provided which have **open cooking system** as well.
Logs can be used for sitting holding (3 to 5) person at a time.

The contour are casted using stone stacked together to achieve the required form and then casted with stabilized mud.

This space can also be used by students for both reading or having their food.



Analyzing the space inside the library we can notice, the counter is totally made and finished using random masonry of stones. An elevated wooden house is made to give cozy feeling to the small students going according to their psychology of understanding space. A letter box and hanging baskets are used for holding books making the spaces more interesting with sit ups around it bringing students together. Recycled and wasted tire are used for seating purpose.

Also a train system is used for both sitting and holding book.

Another section comprises of different raised section with different height creating an interesting space and an underground chamber for holding books.
